

MBBS Course

In compliance with NMC Guidelines, the total course duration comprises 6 years (72 Months) taught course, along with 1 year of clinical rotatory internship.

Eligibility Criteria

- A Score of 50% in required in 12th Class
- Minimum Age: 18 Years
- Candidates applying for MBBS must fulfill all the requirements listed in the guidelines of National Medical Commission (NMC)
- Must have Qualified in NEET Exam
